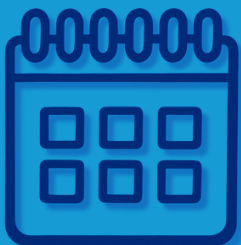

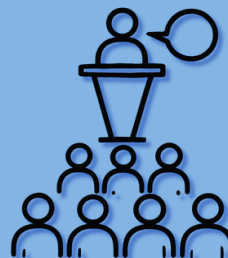

How Long Does Sponsorship Last?

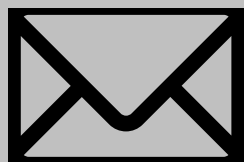
Sponsorship lasts for the full academic year, and goes into effect a week prior on August 19. Organizations can join after this date, but some benefits may be limited depending on the timing.
